

Basic **Dog Commands**

- Heel:** To make your dog walk beside you. Usually on your left side.
- Down, SST, or Whistle:** To make your dog lie down. (used progressively in this order while training).
- Wait or Stay** To make your dog stay.
- Way to Me (Right):** To move your dog to the right around the stock, counter clockwise.
- Come By (Left):** To move your dog to the left around the stock, clockwise.
- That Will Do:** To release your dog from work.
- Way Around:** To send your dog around behind the stock.
- Walk Up:** To make your dog come towards the stock after being on a down command.
- Back:** To keep your dog behind the stock.
- Come Behind:** To make your dog come behind the handler to give more flair to the outrun.
- Get Out:** To move your dog away from the stock (to work wider).
- Come In:** To move your dog closer to the stock (to work closer).
- Stand There:** When you want your dog to STAY in a standing position.
