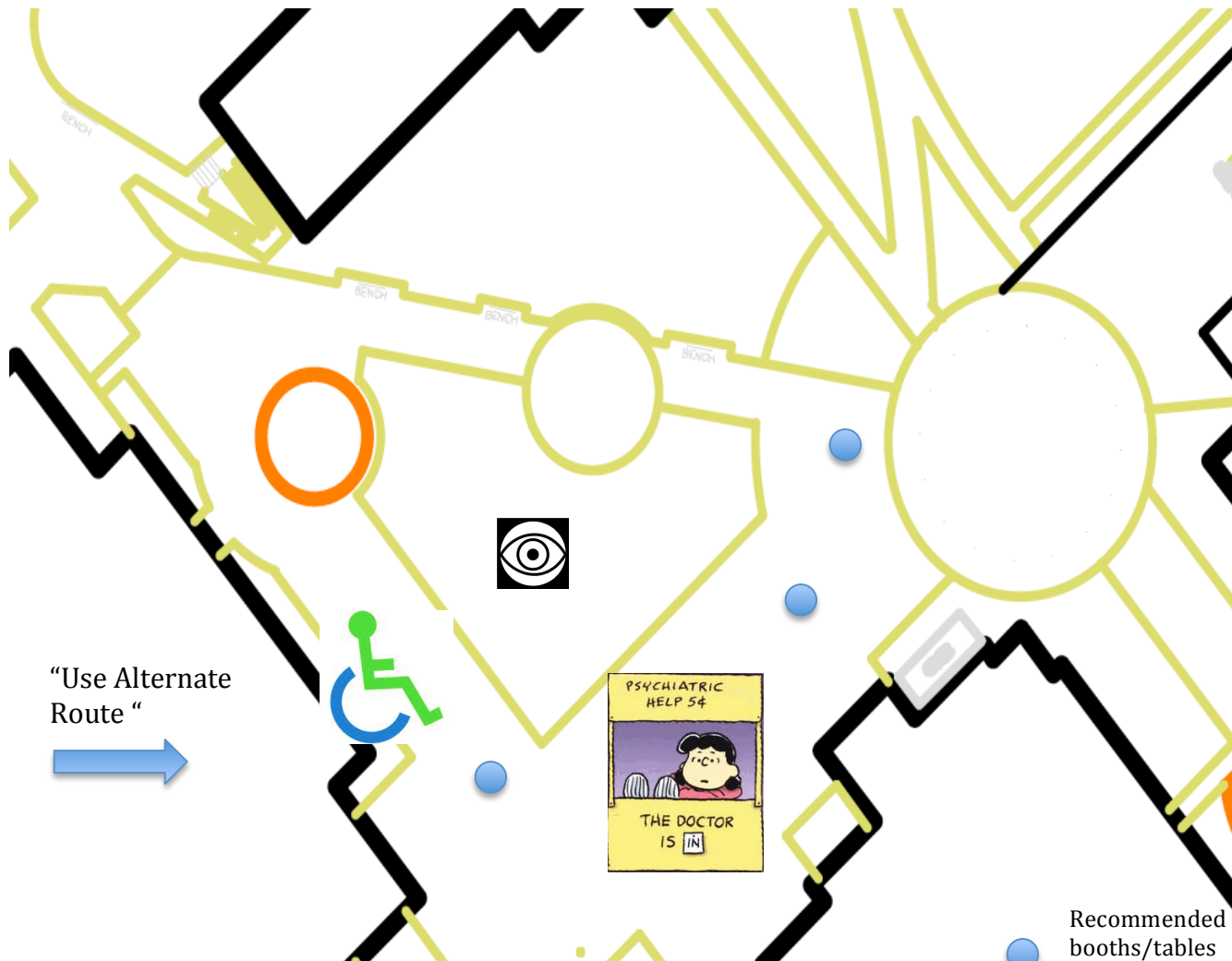


Trinity Commons- Accessible Event Set Up Information

Booths and tables need to be on the perimeter of the lawn area, facing out, with direct access from the sidewalk/concrete. If the booth is intended to be entered, the entire interior needs to be on concrete or other accessible surface. If a sidewalk is blocked to provide access to an activity, be sure to provide sign showing an alternate accessible route.



There needs to be an accessible/unobstructed path of travel around the event and to event activities. If a sidewalk is blocked, there needs to be signage that directs guests to alternate accessible path. If electrical cords cross paths, they need to be covered with mats or secured with tape.



There needs to be a direct line of sight to stages from accessible viewing locations (i.e. view not obstructed by large signs or booths)
