The Child Development Minor is intended to provide interested students a meaningful supplement and expansion of their major, liberal arts education, or professional preparation in specific areas. The CHLD minor uses an interdisciplinary approach to the study of child development and consists of 20 - 21 units — 12 units of required core and 8 - 9 units of elective. Although some of the electives are offered as lower division classes (e.g., community college classes), these courses must be taken for upper division credit for you to receive a minor in Child Development from CSU, Chico.
