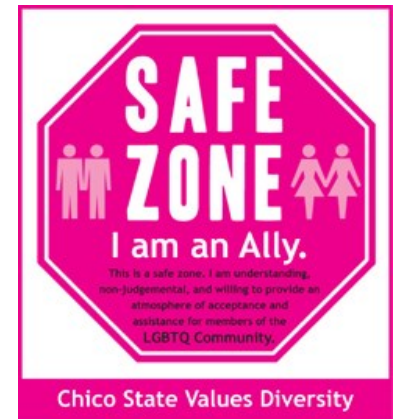


SAFE ZONE 2

Safe Zone 2: Extending your Allyship

In this workshop we will discuss additional concerns and issues for the LGBTQ+ community, struggles, biases & prejudices faced, allyship and how to be an effective ally in diverse situations and scenarios, and time for “hands on” practice about being an ally to the LGBTQ+ community.
