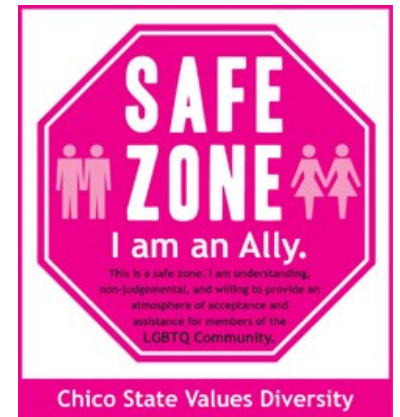


# SAFE ZONE 1 ALLY TRAINING
