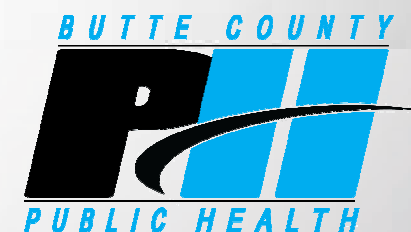
CSU, Chico Information Fair @ Bell Memorial Union (BMU) 10am-5pm
