To participate in the ceremony you will be required to complete a yellow card (available at your department office) that will be used during the ceremony summarizing your achievements and plans after graduation. All graduates who participate in the recognition ceremony will need to wear a cap and gown which may be rented from the A.S. Bookstore (530-898-5222).

Graduates participating in the ceremony are to **arrive by 3:45 pm and assemble on the south lawn of Laxson Auditorium (near 1st Street/Taylor Hall) in cap and gown.** During the ceremony you will be seated by department. Each of you will be introduced as you walk across the stage, followed by some very brief comments read by your department faculty. Students receiving special University medallions will be awarded them at this time. If access to the stage via stairs is a problem, or if you have family with special seating needs, please notify us when you register so that we can do our best to accommodate you.
