Information

Eligibility

Currently enrolled students in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts are invited to submit abstracts of current research, including thesis, honors projects, or other papers or projects completed at the graduate level. Undergraduates must have special permission from faculty supervising work to submit for this conference, unless you are enrolled in an Honors program. All projects must have a faculty sponsor whose signature is included on the application.

Instructions

Students must submit an abstract of research projects or a description of a creative arts project of no more than 300 words on the form provided.

Deadline

All submissions must be received in the Dean's Office in PAC 109 by Friday, March 12.

Workshop

All students will be required to attend a workshop on March 25 or 26.

Research

Students are allotted 15 minutes to present their papers. Sessions will have two or three papers and you may plan a group session. Please list the other presenters for a group session on the application form.

Creative Arts

Visual Arts

Students in the visual and computer arts will have 15 minutes to present a slide or video presentation/visual lecture of their work.

Creative Writing

Poetry, short fiction, and non-fiction may be presented. Students may read from manuscripts and may include, in their 15 minute presentation, information about the context of their reading.

Performing Arts

Participants will have 15 minutes to perform in theatre or music. These can be original works or from established repertory. The performance should include a description of the selection, including the author and text.
