

# GRE FEE REDUCTION CERTIFICATE

Students may apply for GRE Fee Reduction Certificate through the Financial Aid and Scholarship Office. If approved, this certificate may be used for one GRE General Test and/or one GRE Subject Test. ETS only offers a limited number of GRE Fee Reduction Certificates on a first-come, first-served basis. Eligibility for participation in the Fee Reduction Program is limited to one time only. The fee reduction certificate is only valid for one academic year (July 1 through June 30). You must use your certificate within this time period or it will expire. Individuals meeting the eligibility requirements will be required to pay 50% of the full test fee.

To be eligible you must be a U.S. citizen or resident alien who is a college senior or unenrolled college graduate.

## **College seniors:**

- Must be receiving financial aid through an undergraduate college in the United States, U.S. Territories or Puerto Rico
- Dependent students must have an Institutional Student Information Report (ISIR) that shows a parental contribution of no more than \$1400 for the year
- Independent students must have an ISIR that shows a contribution of no more than \$1800 for the year

## **Unenrolled college graduates:**

- A current year FAFSA on file that indicates independent status and a contribution of no more than \$1800

To apply for a GRE Fee Reduction Certificate, please complete the application form and return the original to the Financial Aid and Scholarship Office. We cannot accept photocopies or faxes.

It will take five business days to process your application. You will need to indicate on the application whether you would like to pick up the results at our office or have it mailed to you. Please note that we cannot fax you the results of the application as an original copy is needed to receive the certificate.

Eligible students may apply for a **Fee Reduction Certificate** to be used for one GRE General Test and/or one GRE Subject Test. - If a dependent student, have a Parental Contribution (EFC) of not more than \$1,400 for the senior year, or
- If an independent student, has an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of not more than \$1,800 for the senior year.
