- (3) A signed statement affirming that you understand collection will resume on your discharged loan(s) before any new loan is disbursed to you and, that unless your condition substantially deteriorates, the discharged loan(s) cannot be discharged in the future for any impairment present when you began the discharge or when you tried to get the new loan;
- (4) A signed statement indicating that you understand you must make satisfactory repayment arrangements on the discharged loan(s), if it was defaulted before being discharged, before receiving any new loan.
