Objective: To increase plant life range in the Konkow organic garden allowing students to grow edible plants year round and become educated with greenhouse care.

Specifications According to Walmart.com:

“An affordable, easy way to protect your precious plants, the WeatherGuard 6.5' H x 8' W x 8' L Greenhouse is constructed from 1-1/4" all-steel galvanized tubing and features a triple-ridge
