### Butte Humane Society (BHS) Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Shuttle

On the 1st Thursday of the month, BHS offers a shuttle service from Chico to Walker Street Veterinary Clinic for up to 10 animals (owner pays for the cost). For more information or to register for the shuttle, please contact the shelter at (530) 343-7917.

#### Prices:

\$29.50 for a cat neuter

\$49.50 for a cat spay

\$59 - \$135 dog neuter (depends on weight)

\$68 - \$135 dog spay (depends upon weight)

Additional charge from the vet may apply if animal is in heat or pregnant

BHS charges \$3 per animal to help cover transportation, handling and administrative costs
