

## Chico-USAC Spanish Course Equivalency Table

Chile

- Be advised that only CSU, Chico Spanish faculty may approve transfer equivalents for study abroad courses, and you must get an equivalency form signed by your adviser prior to departure. The signed equivalency form should be submitted to the Study Abroad Office, and you should save a copy for yourself.
- Students should note that only 6 units of Special Topics may count toward a major or minor and that Spanish majors are REQUIRED to take at least one Senior Capstone course at 400 level or above and Spanish 497 in residence at CSU, Chico (not abroad).
