ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Conditional Admission

Conditional admission allows you to start now. Complete an intensive English program at one of our partner language schools, and move directly into your academic program without having to take the TOEFL/IELTS.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS No SAT required

Freshman

- Graduate from a university-preparatory secondary or high school program with a cumulative GPA equivalent to a U.S. 3.0/B or better.
- Achieve a GPA equivalent to a U.S. 2.0/C or better in all university preparatory mathematics courses.

U.S. Transfer

- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA in all transferable coursework
- Complete 24 transferable semester (45 quarter) credits. Credits must include Area A General Education (GE
 - courses with C- or better:
 - A1. Oral communication
 - A2. English composition
 - A4/B4. College-level mathematics
- Good academic standing at last institution attended
- Applicants transferring with fewer than 60 credits must also meet the freshman requirements

Overseas Transfer:

- Minimum 2.4 cumulative GPA in all transferable coursework
- Good academic standing at last institution attended
- Applicants transferring with fewer than 60 credits must meet the freshman requirements

3 ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- Achieve a GPA equivalent to a U.S. 2.75 in the last 60 semester credits and a 3.0 in the last 30 semester credits.
- Programs may require: GRE/GMAT, statement of purpose, letter(s) of recommendation, resumé, etc.
