



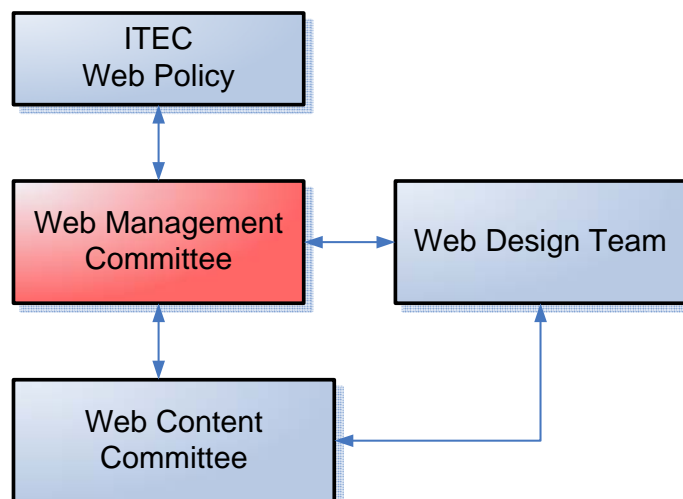
The University Web Management Committee Draft Charge

As directed by Cabinet (9/12/07), University Web Management Committee is charged with oversight and management of the University Web infrastructure and design. It is the responsibility of the committee to gather information from the Design Team, the Content Committee, and other stakeholders to define policy issues and set design and operational guidelines for the campus. Operational issues related to the Chico Web site will be decided by the Management Committee. Policy issues will be referred to the Information Technology Executive Committee for decision.

Based on input from stakeholders, the committee will:

- Define the purpose and the goals of the University Web site for ITEC approval.
- Establish and oversee a Web Design Team that will develop a new Web design and information architecture that meets the established Web site goals.
- Establish and oversee a Web Content Committee that will assure appropriate content of the University's Web presence.
- Assure that Chico's Web site meets the Accessible Technology Initiative goals (by June 9, 2009).
- Approve campus standards on the breadth and depth of the common Chico design and information architecture.
- Approve standards and guidelines for managing public Web pages at CSU, Chico.
- Recommend policy to ITEC as required to meet the objectives of the CSU, Chico Web site.
