

Graduating in Four Years News-Editorial Option

Beginning major classes as soon as possible is the best way to ensure graduation within four years. (Taking JOUR 101 and JOUR 260 as a sophomore is the key to timely advancement through the program.)

The following guide is for students who begin the program as juniors.

Semester One

- JOUR 101
- JOUR 260* (ENGL 130 is prerequisite to JOUR 260.)
- JOUR 255
- GE Theme courses

* A grade of C or better is required in J260 to progress in the major

Semester Two

- JOUR 321
- JOUR 327
- Group A or B course
- Minor courses

Semester Three

- JOUR 320
- JOUR 329
- 1 or 2 courses chosen from Group A or B or C
- Minor courses

Semester Four

- JOUR 460
- 1 or 2 courses chosen from Group A or B or C
- Minor courses or GE Courses
