

Graduating in Four Years Public Relations Option

Beginning major classes as soon as possible is the best way to ensure graduation within four years. (Taking JOUR 101 and JOUR 260 as a sophomore is the key to timely advancement through the program.) What follows is a guide for students beginning the journalism program as juniors.

Semester One

- JOUR 101
- JOUR 260 ENGL 130 is prerequisite to JOUR 260.
- JOUR 244
- Minor courses
- GE courses

Semester Two

- JOUR 341
- JOUR 342
- 1-2 courses chosen from Group A or B or C
- JOUR 255

Semester Three

- JOUR 344
- 1-3 courses chosen from Group A or B or C
- Minor courses or GE courses

Semester Four

- JOUR 460
- JOUR 445
- 1 or 2 courses chosen from Group A or B or C
- Minor courses

(NOTE: J344 cannot be taken until you complete J341. And J445 cannot be taken until you complete J344. You may NOT take J344 and J445 at the same time)
