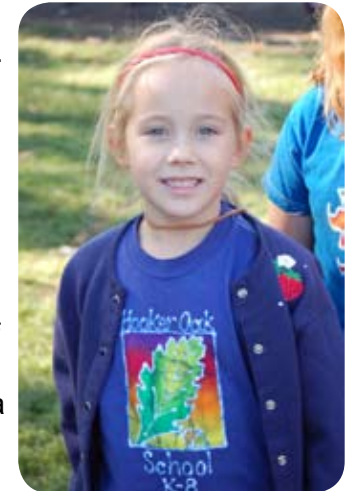
Our Goals
