

FLOYD L. ENGLISH NATURAL SCIENCES SCHOLARSHIPS 2008-09

Eight to Twelve Scholarships To Be Awarded: \$2,500 - \$20,000
Application Deadline: Monday, March 17, 2008

Scholarships are available to College of Natural Sciences majors, including: Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Environmental Science, Geology, Geosciences, Mathematics, Microbiology, Nursing, Nutrition and Food Sciences, Physics, and Pre-Nursing.

The deciding criterion for the award is the student's potential for achievement in a profession that is science or mathematics based.

- I. For the 2008-09 academic year, eight to twelve scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 to \$20,000 each will be awarded to deserving students who are majoring in a program in the College of Natural Sciences. Any undergraduate in good academic standing in the College is eligible to apply this year. (If you hold a bachelor's degree, you are not eligible to apply.)

Freshmen will be eligible for up to a four-year scholarship (initial award and three years potential renewal for a total of up to \$20,000).
Sophomores will be eligible for up to a three-year scholarship (initial award and two years potential renewal for a total of up to \$15,000).
Juniors will be eligible for up to a two-year scholarship (initial award and one year potential renewal for a total of up to \$10,000).
Seniors will be eligible for a one year award only (up to \$5,000). (Award will not be extended to graduate studies.)
- II. The enclosed **application packet must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 17, 2008**, in the College of Natural Sciences; California State University, Chico; Chico, CA 95929-0555 (Holt Hall, Room 285), 530-898-6121. (**Faxed copies will not be accepted.**)
 - a. The application form with pertinent personal and academic information.
 - b. A (one page maximum) letter of application discussing your personal and professional goals.
 - c. Three (one page maximum) letters of recommendation from high school/college advisors, current mathematics or science teachers, mentors, employers, or business professionals. These letters should address academic achievement, financial need, involvement in student activities, community service, professional goals, personal qualities that indicate potential for success and how this scholarship will make a difference.
- III. Selection of recipients:

Semi-finalists will be chosen on the basis of written application materials and **will be required to interview on the Chico State campus on Monday, April 14 or Tuesday, April 15, 2008.** **Recipients** of scholarships will be notified no later than April 23, 2007, and **will be required to attend a luncheon and reception on the Chico State campus on Friday, May 16, 2008.**
