Goals: This conference will enable participants to expand their simulation toolbox to develop simulations for use in their educational settings. The course will make you feel at ease with the technology and methodology of simulation education. The results will rejuvenate your simulation program. This course will take instructors to the next level of simulation design. Complex scenario development will be reviewed and debriefing will be a focal point.

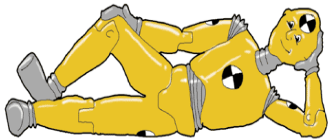
