Course Goals: This conference will enable participants to expand their simulation toolbox to develop simulations for use in their educational settings. The course will make you feel at ease with the technology and methodology of simulation education. The results will rejuvenate your simulation program. This is not a course for beginners! This course is designed to take novice simulation instructors to the next level of simulation design. Complex scenario development will be reviewed and debriefing will be a focal point.

Participants will:

- Discover new ways to “suspend disbelief” as they master the art of simulation design.
- Polish debriefing skills and discover tools to assist in debriefing
- Evaluate simulation exercises and simulation scenarios
- Explore current research and best practice in the field of simulation
- Design, direct and debrief a case utilizing simulation tools and techniques.
- Discuss the challenges and changes necessary to integrate simulation into educational curricula in both the healthcare and school setting.
- Understand how to create realism and fidelity in simulation.
- Discover innovations to improve clinical education and practice.
- Become familiar with new products and resources.

Topics include:

- Evaluation methods to buff up your simulation outcomes.
- Strengthen your simulation scenario design.
- Examine the evidence to support simulation technology.
- Relax by learning about new technology tools.
- Scenario validation and testing to feel the burn of success.
- Get off the treadmill to plan a successful simulation day.
- Explore ways to create simulation reality.
- Take the stress out of debriefing.

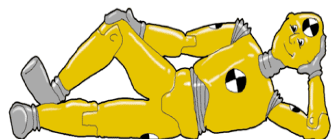
