Application Requirements for 2012 MSN Program

1. BSN degree in nursing from a program accredited by a national nursing accrediting body with a minimum GPA of 3.0 in the last 60 units of undergraduate nursing courses
2. Current California license to practice as a registered nurse.
3. A 3 unit course in basic statistics with a grade of C or better completed within the seven years prior to admission.
4. Completion of the Graduate Record Exam previous five years. Recommended GRE scores for exams taken on or after August 1, 2011 are a minimum of 150 each in verbal reasoning and quantitative reasoning. Analytical writing minimum is 4.0 Students who have taken the GRE before August 1, 2011 are expected to have achieved a minimum verbal score of 450 and a minimum quantitative score of 500. Analytical writing score of 4.0.
5. Completed application on file at the CSU Chico Graduate School.
6. A letter of intent submitted to the Graduate Coordinator in the School of Nursing to document why the applicant is seeking admission at this MSN program and what the applicant's future goals are for this degree.
