PLEASE DO NOT REQUEST TRANSCRIPTS TO BE SUBMITTED SEPARATELY.**

Applications will not be accepted after March 1, 2012. Applications “postmarked” on March 1, 2012, or any date after, will not be accepted. **If you are mailing your application, mail it several days prior to the deadline, allowing enough time to reach the School of Nursing office by March 1, 2012.**

Please review the Admission Requirements on our website, www.csuchico.edu/nurs prior to filling out the application. The Admission Requirements include detailed information on the selection criteria that is used at CSU, Chico School of Nursing.

Submit application below and all supporting documents (transcripts, verification letters, etc.) together. Please do not mail documents separately. Supporting documents include official transcripts of **all** colleges attended, unofficial high school transcripts (if showing proof of language proficiency), and verification letters (on business letterhead).

Please note: Even if you submitted your official transcripts to the CSUC Office of Admissions, you must submit an additional copy to the School of Nursing with your application.

If you took the TEAS at Chico, your score will be e-mailed to us directly from ATI. However, **if you took the TEAS at a location other than CSU, Chico, contact ATI (Assessment Technologies Institute) and request that your score be sent (via e-mail) directly to CSU, Chico School of Nursing.** There will be a charge from ATI for this service.
