

## REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEMESTER V – FALL 2009

Be sure to activate your CSU Chico Portal to get updated communications on all your classes. Go to the campus home page and click on the Portal icon in the lower right corner.

Reminders of Nursing requirements: ENGL 1 (grade of C- or better) and Speech must be complete before taking Nursing 422. You will need access to your own transportation for N424 clinical.

"Clinical Requirements Update" forms will be distributed to you before the end of the semester.

- ◆ All updates (with verification attached to the update form) must be complete and handed in to the Nursing Office by August 17, 2009. If this form is not submitted on time, you will be disenrolled from Nursing 424/434 and will have to add these courses once the required paperwork is in, taking any section that remains available. Disenrollment may affect your financial aid eligibility.
- ◆ Schedule CPR renewal now! CPR Recerts must be completed by August 17, 2009. CPR is good only for one year, regardless of what your card says. You may not attend clinical if your CPR card has not been renewed within the past year! This is absolute. Do not go past the expiration date on the form we hand you or you will be removed from clinical. Please note that the CPR card needs to state "Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Provider". If you have not taken the correct CPR course, you will be required to repeat the correct course and not be allowed in clinical.
- ◆ Clinical includes all orientation days as well as skills lab days.
- ◆ Purchase your course supplement on Monday, August 24th, at 8:00 a.m. in Holt 371.
- ◆ Orientation for all Semester V students will be on August 24<sup>th</sup> in Holt 363 from 8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. N424 orientation for first rotations will be from 10:15 a.m. – 12:15 p.m. in Holt 363. Orientation for N434 for first rotation students will be 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. Please dress in appropriate street clothes, not uniforms. Appropriate means no low-cut, see-through blouses, no shorts, no bare midriffs. No open-toed shoes.

Note: Scheduling flexibility will be imperative to successfully complete clinical hours for Nurs.424. Be aware that it is likely that your clinical days will change weekly and that you will need to do some weekend clinical days and possibly night shifts to fit your preceptor's schedule. If you are employed, your work schedule must be flexible to accommodate your preceptor's schedule.
