

**Course Information  
Spring 2012**

There is a mandatory orientation on Friday, January 20, 2012 in Holt 359, 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. Please be on time, as the meeting will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m.

Check your CSU, Chico Portal to get updated communication on all your classes.

**Nursing requirements** – Child or Human Development, Principles of Psychology, Nutrition, and Sociology or Cultural Anthropology must be completed prior to the end of semester 1. Transcripts of courses taken must be submitted to the School of Nursing Office to be included in your file.

**PPD** - If you are enrolled in NURS 284 - section 3 at Feather River Hospital, you must have two negative PPD tests within the past calendar year (Ideally these tests would be no more than 3 months apart).

**CPR Certification** - If your CPR card is expiring soon, schedule CPR Certification now. Make sure the CPR card states "Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Provider". Do not let your CPR expire or you will be removed from clinical. The CPR card is now good for **two years**.

**Financial Aid** - Semester 1 nursing courses total 12 units (NURS 282 (2 units); NURS 283 (4 units); NURS 284 (4 units); NURS 285 (2 units), which meets the requirement for financial aid.
