

**Course Information  
Spring 2012**

Check your Wildcat e-mail for updated communications on all your classes.

Orientation: All students will meet on Monday, January 23, **and** Tuesday, January 24, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:50 p.m. Please check your N314 Vista class online for the location of the Monday, January 23 orientation.

Your course supplement will be available on VISTA one week prior to the beginning of school. Please print a copy of the supplement and bring it to class on **Monday, January 23**.

- Updates of all clinical requirements (CPR, health and auto insurance, immunizations) must be completed and **copies** of all documents must be hand-delivered or mailed to the School of Nursing office by January 16, 2012. If this documentation is not submitted on time, students will be dropped from N314. Once the paperwork is turned in, you will have to add the courses again, taking any section that remains available. Disenrollment may affect your financial aid eligibility.

**Note:** *“Clinical” includes all orientation days as well as skills lab days.*

- **If your CPR expires, you will be removed from clinical.** Schedule CPR renewal now if it is expiring! CPR must be *updated* by January 16, 2012, and is now good for two years. The CPR card needs to read, "Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Provider." Be sure you take the correct course.

**Clinical Rotations** - All sections rotate through acute (hospital) OB and Peds, and community maternal/child facilities. All these schedules are subject to change because of negotiations and arrangements made with the hospitals. Other nursing schools use these agencies as well.

Additional skills lab orientations:

N314 – sections 1 and 2 will meet Thurs., January 26, 2012 from 3:00 pm – 5:00 pm

N314 – sections 3 and 4 will meet Thurs., February 2, 2012 from 3:00 pm – 5:00 pm

**Sections 1 and 2** will have a hospital orientation day at Enloe on Monday, January 30 from 9:00am-3:00pm.

**Sections 3 and 4** will have a hospital orientation day at Mercy Hospital in Redding, CA on Friday, February 3 from 9:00am-3:00pm.

Rotations for OB/Peds are described for each section, below. Additional experiences at the Alpine House, Better Babies and the Simulation Lab are scheduled around your acute hospital time, on Mondays and Tuesdays. The assignment of clinical experiences will be given on the first day of school. *All students will know their whole schedule by the end of the first day of school.* There will be an occasional Mon. or Tues, when there is no clinical. Total hours are 135. Dates provided here are still tentative.

**Tentative Section 1 dates:** Enloe Hospital in Chico for acute Pediatrics and OB. - January 31 through March 13, 12-hour shifts, 6:45 a.m. – 6:45 p.m. (Tuesdays)

**Tentative Section 2 dates:** Enloe Hospital in Chico for acute Pediatrics and OB. - March 27 through May 8, 12-hour shifts, 6:45 a.m. – 6:45 p.m. (Tuesdays)

**Sections 3 and 4:** Mercy Hospital in Redding for acute Pediatrics and OB. Fri and Sat are the clinical days, 12-hour shifts, 6:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. (Fri. and Sat., alternate each week).

**Section 3 dates:** Feb. 17, Feb. 25, March 2, March 10, April 6, April 14, and April 20.

**Section 4 dates:** Feb. 18, Feb. 24, March 3, March 9, April 7, April 13, and April 21.
