

**Course Information
Spring 2012**

Register for Courses: N463, N474, N475, N484, N493, and N494. (See Class Schedule on the web.) Course syllabi and supplements will be available in VISTA. Please print all documents prior to class.

Orientation for all N474 students is scheduled for Wednesday, January 25, 2012, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., location TBD. Please check your wildcat e-mail or N474 Vista page for additional information.

Orientation for N484 – All sections will have orientations on Thursday, January 26, 2011 at the Simulation Center at the following times:

Updates of all clinical requirements (CPR, health and auto insurance, immunizations) must be completed and **copies** of all documents must be hand-delivered or mailed to the School of Nursing office by January 16, 2012. If documentation is not submitted on time, students will be dropped from N474/N494. Disenrollment may affect your financial aid eligibility.

Note: “clinical” includes all orientation days as well as skills lab days.

If your CPR expires, you will be removed from clinical. Schedule CPR renewal now, if it is expiring! CPR must be updated by July 16, 2012 and is now good for **two years**. The CPR card needs to read, "Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Provider."

Please Note: Students completing their N494 clinical section at Rideout Hospital will be required to complete a **10-panel** drug screen at a Federally accredited laboratory no more than 30 days before the first date of the clinical, even if you completed a prior drug test for the School of Nursing. This is non-negotiable. In Chico, you can use Paramex lab, 1450 Sherman Avenue, to have your test done (approx. \$49.00). If you complete the drug test at Paramex in Chico, you will need to provide a copy to Fremont no later than the day of your orientation to clinical. Copies of your drug screen results should also be provided to the School of Nursing.

You can also complete the drug test at the Urgent Care Center associated with Fremont/Rideout Hospital (approx. \$50). To do this, schedule an appointment with Fremont Hospital's Human Resource (HR) Dept. by phone. On the day of the appointment, go to the HR department, 620 J. Street, Marysville (old cannery building by Save Mart), and fill out a form. You will then be sent to the Urgent Care Center at the north end of Plumas Street to do the

drug test. You will have to wait for a few minutes for a print-out of the drug test results to hand- carry back to HR, and they will take your photograph and make the badge for your clinical there.

About Courses 493 and 494:

493 is on Friday mornings, 8:00-10:00 for half of the semester (section 1 – first half of the semester, Registration #6237; section 2 – second half of the semester – Registration #6238)

494 Sections 1 & 2 register for 493, section 1; 494 sections 3 & 4 register for 493, section 2.

N494, section 1 (Registration #6285) & section 3 (Registration #6287) are at Enloe Hospital on Mon-Tues (2 p.m. to 11 p.m.) for 10 days. (See Semester VI board).

N494, section 2 (Registration #6286) & section 4 (Registration #6288) are at Rideout Hospital in Marysville on Mon.-Tues (6:30 a.m. to 2:50 pm) for 10 days. (See Semester VI board).

About Courses 474 and 484:

N474 is on Wednesdays or Thursdays for the entire semester with a seminar. You need to be aware that there are very few placements in Chico for the Public Health Nursing clinical. Please be sure to indicate your location and clinical preference on the form that will be distributed to you prior to the start of the semester. The form is more important than the registration sections! The sections will be adjusted according to clinical placement during the first week of school. This will be coordinated with your 484 course. Plan to meet from 1:00-3:00 pm on 5 Fridays (10 hours) of the semester for the 474 public health seminar. The dates of seminars will be decided during the 474 Orientation.
