

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEMESTER III – SPRING 2010

Be sure to check your Wildcat e-mail to get updated communications on all your classes. Faculty will also use VISTA to communicate with students regarding other nursing classes. If you are not familiar with the VISTA format, be sure to familiarize yourself with it prior to the start of semester III.

Reminders of Nursing requirements:

Intro. Sociology or Cultural Anthropology must be taken prior to Sem. IV. Transcripts of courses taken must be submitted to the School of Nursing Office to be included in your file.

"Clinical Requirement Update" forms will be distributed to you before the end of the semester.

- All updates (with verification attached to the update form) must be complete and handed in to the Nursing Office by January 14, 2010. If this form is not submitted on time, you will be disenrolled from Nursing 304 and will have to add this course once the required paperwork is in, taking any section that remains available. Disenrollment may affect your financial aid eligibility.
- Schedule CPR renewal now! CPR Recerts must be completed by January 14, 2010. CPR is good only for one year, regardless of what your card says. You may not attend clinical if your CPR card has not been renewed within the past year! This is absolute. Do not go past the expiration date on the form we hand you or you will be removed from clinical. Clinical includes all orientation days as well as skills lab days. Please note that the CPR card needs to state "Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Provider". If you have not taken the correct CPR course, you will be required to repeat the correct course and not be allowed in clinical.
- Your course supplement and syllabus will be available in VISTA. Please print a copy and bring to class on Monday, January 25th.
- Classes for Semester III will begin promptly at 11 a.m., January 25, 2010 in Holt 277. Faculty will post a lecture outline and reading assignments prior to your first class. Be sure to check your N303 course email (VISTA) and come to class prepared for lecture.
- Clinical orientations for all Sections of Nurs 304 will be on Monday, January 25th at approximately 2:45 p.m. Please check VISTA for times and locations of your clinical orientations.
- There will be an on-campus orientation for NURS 305 on Wednesday, January 27, 2010 @ 1 pm in Holt Hall, Room 359
- You will need a lab coat, name tag, pencil, and Nursing 304 course information available in VISTA for clinical orientation.

NURS 303 - Registration #4889

NURS 305 - Registration #4891 (primarily online; some required meetings)

NURS 304 - Section 1 (Registration #4940) and Section 2 (Registration #4941) will be at Enloe Medical Center.

NURS 304 - Section 3 will be at Oroville Hospital in Oroville (Registration #4942)

NURS 304 - Section 4 will be at Feather River Hospital in Paradise. (Registration #4943)

Reminder: You will need to have your own transportation to meet clinical requirements in Semesters IV, V and VI. You may include the required costs for clinical transportation in your request to financial aid request for next year, including car purchase, automobile insurance, registration and estimated mileage.

There will be an on-campus final exam, during finals week.
