

## REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEMESTER IV – Spring 2010

Be sure to check your Wildcat e-mail to get updated communications on all your classes.

**The first week all students meet on Mon, January 25th and Tue. January 26<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 to 2:50.**

Check your wildcat e-mail in early January or the Semester 4 bulletin board for the location of your first class meeting on Monday, January 25<sup>th</sup>.

Reminders of Nursing requirements:

1. Intro. Sociology or Cultural Anthropology must be taken prior to Sem. IV. Transcripts of courses taken must be submitted to the School of Nursing Office to be included in your file.
2. You will need a car and auto insurance for much of your clinical courses from this semester on.

"Clinical Requirements Update" forms will be distributed to you before the end of the semester.

- ◆ All updates (with verification attached to the update form) must be complete and handed in to the Nursing Office by January 14, 2010. If this form is not submitted on time, you will be disenrolled from Nursing 314 and will have to add this course once the required paperwork is in, taking any section that remains available. Disenrollment may affect your financial aid eligibility.
- ◆ Schedule CPR renewal now! CPR Recerts must be *completed* by January 14, 2010. CPR is good only for one year, regardless of what your card says. You may not attend clinical if your CPR card has not been renewed within the past year! This is absolute. Do not go past the expiration date on the form we hand you or you will be removed from clinical. Please note that the CPR card needs to state "Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Provider". If you have not taken the correct CPR course, you will be required to repeat the correct course and not be allowed in clinical.
- ◆ Clinical includes all orientation days as well as skills lab days. If you do not have your clinical requirements update form completed, you will not be able to attend the clinical orientation sessions.
- ◆ Your course supplement will be available on VISTA one week prior to the beginning of school. Please print a copy of the supplement and bring to class on January 25, 2010.
- ◆ A fingerprint background clearance is required for you to participate in Semester IV clinicals. Instructions for obtaining that clearance will be presented in December. This clearance is required because of state laws for protection of children.
- ◆ A urine drug screen will be required. Details will be provided in December.

Clinical Rotation details: All sections rotate through acute (hospital) OB and Peds, and community maternal/child facilities. Keep in mind that all these schedules are subject to change because of negotiations and arrangements we have to make with the hospitals and other nursing

schools using them. Caution—do not go by what previous semester students tell you about the schedule—it is different every semester!

Additional skills lab orientations:

N314 – sections 1 and 2 will meet Thur., February 4<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 pm – 1:50 pm

N314 – sections 3 and 4 will meet Thur., February 11<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 pm – 1:50 pm

Everyone will have a hospital orientation all day on Tuesday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>

Rotations for hospital OB/Peds are described for each section, below. Additional experiences at the Alpine House, Better Babies and the Simulation Lab are scheduled around your acute hospital time, on Mondays and Tuesdays. The assignment of clinical experiences will be done on the first day of school. All students will know their whole schedule by the end of the first day of school. There will be some Mon. or Tues, when there is no clinical. Total hours are 135. Dates provided here are still tentative.

Sec. 1 & 2 will be at Fremont Hosp in Yuba City for Pediatrics and OB on Tuesdays, 6:30 am – 6:30 pm and one additional preceptored day will be scheduled on a Sunday

Tentative section 1 dates are February 9<sup>th</sup> through March 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Tentative section 2 dates are March 30<sup>th</sup> through May 4<sup>th</sup>.

Sec. 3 and 4 will be at Mercy Hospital in Redding for acute OB and Peds. Fri and Sat are the clinical days, 12-hour shifts, 6:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. (Fri. and Sat., alternate each week).

Tentative section 3 dates begin February 12<sup>th</sup> through April 9<sup>th</sup>.

Tentative section 4 dates begin February 13<sup>th</sup> through April 10<sup>th</sup>.

If you work weekends, Sections 1 & 2 require less weekend shifts.

If you need to take other non-nursing classes – the late afternoons (after 4:00 p.m.) or evenings would be possible on the days you don't have clinical.
