

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEMESTER V – SPRING 2010

Be sure to check your Wildcat e-mail to get updated communications on all your classes.

- ◆ Orientation for all Semester V students will be on January 25th in Holt 363 from 8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. N424 orientation for first rotations will be from 10:15 a.m. – 12:15 p.m. in Holt 363. Orientation for N434 for first rotation students will be 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. Please dress in appropriate street clothes, not uniforms. Appropriate means no low-cut, see-through blouses, no shorts, no bare midriffs. No open-toed shoes.

Reminders of Nursing requirements: ENGL 1 (grade of C- or better) and Speech must be complete before taking Nursing 422. You will need access to your own transportation for N424 clinical.

“Clinical Requirements Update” forms will be distributed to you before the end of the semester.

- ◆ All updates (with verification attached to the update form) must be complete and handed in to the Nursing Office by January 14, 2010. If this form is not submitted on time, you will be disenrolled from Nursing 424 and 434 and will have to add this course once the required paperwork is in, taking any section that remains available. Disenrollment may affect your financial aid eligibility.
- ◆ Schedule CPR renewal now! CPR Recerts must be completed by January 14, 2010. CPR is good only for one year, regardless of what your card says. You may not attend clinical if your CPR card has not been renewed within the past year! This is absolute. Do not go past the expiration date on the form we hand you or you will be removed from clinical. Please note that the CPR cards needs to state “Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Provider”.
- ◆ Clinical includes all orientation days as well as skills lab days.

Course supplements and syllabi (N422, N424, N433, and N434) will be available in VISTA and will not be distributed in class. The instructors have asked that you print the syllabi prior to January 25, 2010 and bring to the first class meetings.

Nursing 444 is a leadership mentorship rotation. You will be paired with a nursing leader/manager mentor, and will work on specific assignments with your mentor on a flexible schedule arranged by you and the mentor throughout the semester, for a total of 90 hours. This experience includes on-campus seminars, clinical time with the preceptor and on-line learning activities.

Register for only one first rotation section, and one second rotation section.

Note: Scheduling flexibility will be imperative to successfully complete clinical hours for Nurs.424. Be aware that it is likely that your clinical days will change weekly and that you will need to do some weekend clinical days and possibly night shifts to fit your preceptor's schedule. If you are employed, your work schedule must be flexible to accommodate your preceptor's schedule.
