

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEMESTER VI – SPRING 2010

Orientation for all N474 students is scheduled for Wednesday, January 27, 2010, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Please check your wildcat e-mail or the N474 vista page for the location.

"Clinical Requirements Update" forms will be distributed to you before the end of the semester.

- ◆ All updates (with verification attached to the update form) must be complete and handed in to the Nursing Office by January 14, 2010. If this form is not submitted on time, you will be disenrolled from Nursing 474/494 and will have to add these courses once the required paperwork is in, taking any section that remains available. Disenrollment may affect your financial aid eligibility.
- ◆ Schedule CPR renewal now! CPR Recerts must be completed by January 14, 2010. CPR is good only for one year, regardless of what your card says. You may not attend clinical if your CPR card has not been renewed within the past year! This is absolute. Do not go past the expiration date on the form we hand you or you will be removed from clinical. Please note that the CPR card needs to state "Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Provider". If you have not taken the correct CPR course, you will be required to repeat the correct course and not be allowed in clinical.
- ◆ Clinical includes all orientation days as well as skills lab days.
- ◆ Please note—for community health agencies, we must have verification that you carry auto insurance this semester. It is not feasible to carpool for your N474 assignments, so be sure you arrange to have a reliable automobile with auto insurance.
- ◆ Course syllabi and supplements will be available in VISTA. Please print all documents prior to class.

INFORMATION ON HOW TO REGISTER: Take N463, N475, N474, N493, and N494. (See Class Schedule on the web)

There are several things you need to know about Semester 6.

- ◆ You will have 493 on Friday mornings from 8-10 for half of the semester (**Section 1** – first half of the semester – **Registration #4906**; **Section 2** – second half of the semester – **Registration #4907**)
- ◆ 494 section 1 & 2 should register for 493 section 1; 494 sections 3 and 4 should register for 493 section 2.
- ◆ N494 Section 1 (Registration #4956) & Section 3 (Registration #4958) are at Enloe Hospital on Mon-Tues (2 p.m. to 11 p.m.) for 10 days (see Semester VI board).
- ◆ N494 Section 2 (Registration #4957) & Section 4 (Registration #4959) are at Rideout Hospital in Marysville on Mon.-Tues (6:30 a.m. to 2:50 pm) for 10 days (see Semester VI board).
- ◆ N474 is on Wednesdays or Thursdays for the entire semester with a seminar on selected Fridays from 1:00-3:00 p.m. You need to be aware that there are very few placements in Chico for Community Health clinical, so be prepared to *drive, drive, drive*. If any students from Shasta County want to do their N474 (Community Health Clinical) in Redding, register for N474, section 3. Be sure to indicate your clinical preference on the form that will be distributed to you in class.

- ◆ Keep Wednesdays and Thursdays available for the first three weeks, regardless of the day your N474 is scheduled, to be available for agency orientations.
- ◆ N463 (Registration #4902) will meet on the first Friday afternoon (January 29th) from 1 p.m. to 1:50 p.m. The remainder is online except for two mandatory meetings in May, 2010, from 1:30-4:20 pm.
- ◆ N475 (Registration #4931) will be on Friday mornings from 10:00 a.m. to 12:50 p.m.
- ◆ There are only 10 units in Sem. VI. If you're receiving financial aid you may have to enroll for 12 units. N399 is offered CR/NC only. If you wish to be considered for the Dean's list (GPA 3.5 or better) you have to carry 12 graded units, so a CR/NC class won't qualify.
- ◆ A special topics course is available – NURS 398 for 2 units (S. Fox, instructor) to pilot test capstone simulation experiences. This course will be graded. The schedule will be set to work around N474 and N494 schedules, for a total of 30 hours. This course is available only for 6 semester students.
