RATIONALE: The Department of Political Science has five undergraduate programs and two graduate programs: BA in Political Science: General Option. BA in Political Science: Legal Studies Option, BA in Criminal Justice, BA in International Relations, BA in Public Administration, MA in Political Science, and MPA in Public Administration. The number of majors for the department's five undergraduate programs is about 1,050 students as of fall 2015, not including graduate students. Of those 1,050 undergraduate students, about 650 of them are criminal justice students.

Prompted by enrollment trends, faculty members in the Department of Political Science propose to change the name of the department by adding "and Criminal Justice" so that the new name better reflects the department's present-day focus and breadth. More than half of the department's students are seeking a degree in criminal justice, but that degree option is not reflected in the department's current name. Because criminal justice is not a traditional field of study within political science, the current name is not inclusive enough to also represent criminal justice, making a new name desirable. Our department is no longer focused only on the traditional fields of political science, but our current name implies that we are. The proposed new name is more inclusive and better represents the nature of our department.
