

Deferred Payment Plans

The CSU offers two deferred installment payment plans to assist **non-financial aid students**. The first plan, the State University Fee (SUF) Installment Contract, is available to all non-financial aid students and will defer two-thirds of the State University Fee for all eligible students who apply. This plan has a \$33 non-refundable service charge. The second plan, the Deferred Tuition Contract, is for non-residents and will defer the additional tuition payments required of non-resident students only. The second plan has a 15% service charge. Both deferred payment contracts must be signed and non-deferred registration fees must be received by the Registration Fee Payment Deadline or all classes in which you are enrolled will be dropped.

The SUF Installment Contract form is provided below for your convenience. Non-resident students may request a Deferred Tuition Contract form from Student Financial Services, Kendall 214, or call 530-898-5936. To use the SUF Fee Installment Contract form, please make a copy of this page, fill it out completely, sign where indicated, make an additional copy for your records, and forward the original with your payment to Student Financial Services, CSU, Chico, Chico, CA 95929-0999 so that it will be received by the Registration Fee Payment Deadline.

I wish to use the installment plan for the State University Fee (SUF) as authorized by Section 89700.1 of the Education Code. I am not eligible for any other campus waivers, subsidies or deferrals, such as a financial aid deferral, and I have not filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

I understand that this deferral applies only to a portion of the State University Fee and that all other registration fees including a \$33.00 installment plan fee must be RECEIVED by Student Financial Services-Cashiering by the Registration Fee Payment Deadline or all my classes will be dropped.

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*Fees are subject to change by the State Legislature and Trustees of the California State University. Any increase in the State University Fee or other registration fees will be due in addition to the currently deferred State University Fee in two equal installments as indicated above.

If the first payment is dishonored by the bank, it will be treated as non-payment and I may be subject to disenrollment. I further understand that if the 2nd or 3rd payment is not received by Student Financial Services-Cashiering on or before the due dates specified or should my payment be dishonored by the bank, I will be assessed a \$20.00 Past Due fee for each missed payment and a hold will be placed on my record until payment is received. I understand I will be unable to register for a future semester or receive transcripts until all fees and penalties are paid in full.

I further agree to pay the total of this contract whether or not academic credit is received for the courses in which I am enrolled at the end of the second week of classes. If I withdraw from the University or drop classes after the second week of classes, I understand that I am still responsible for the total balance of this contract, unless such withdrawal or decrease in unit load is a result of a verified physical disability, involuntary military conscription, or my death.

I understand that failure to pay the amount due may result in referral of the debt to an outside collection agency and/or credit reporting agency; offset against amounts due from the State of California; and/or legal action. I agree to pay all costs of collection, including attorney fees and court costs.

Payments must be received on or before each respective due date.
