



Navigating WebCT

CSU, Chico has linked WebCT with the CSC Portal. To access WebCT, login to the Portal at <http://portal.csuchico.edu>. After logging in, click on the "My Course Resources" tab to bring up your course list.

WebCT has internal navigation links. WebCT strongly recommends that you do not use your browser's Back and Forward buttons. To navigate WebCT screens, use the links provided in the following features:

Breadcrumbs

From the list of courses you are currently enrolled in, click the title of the course. This will take you into that course, directly onto the course homepage.

On the Course Homepage, you can navigate using either the Course Menu, located on the upper left side of the page. The Course Menu links to commonly used course resources, such as the Homepage, or a Syllabus. This links will always be available, wherever you are in the course.

Probably the most common type of navigation in WebCT is simply using the icons. On the WebCT homepage, there will be clickable icons. These icons will vary based on your instructor's choice of what to include in the course.

Breadcrumbs are located on the Menu Bar. They show your location in the course and provide links to previous screens. To return to a previous screen, click the corresponding screen name in the breadcrumbs.
