PROFESSIONAL SEQUENCE

Students will be applying to the Professional Sequence in their 1st Fall Semester.

All BSW students must pass their prerequisites with a "C grade" or higher in order to move into the Professional Sequence.

Only ONE Social Work elective is required and can be taken in either the Fall or Spring.

(O) = All Online; (H) = Hybrid, some face-to-face time required; (F) = Field Placement

IMPORTANT PROGRAM DETAILS:

- BSW Program Orientation is the week prior to the 1st Fall Semester; it is **MANDATORY**
- 2 weekends of face-to-face campus meetings during each semester (including summer)
- 3 Upper Division GE Pathway Courses required – Students may take them in any semester, the above schedule is a suggested schedule
- 1 Social Work Elective is required for graduation: choose SWRK 320, 474, or 478

APPLYING TO THE PROFESSIONAL SEQUENCE:

- There are 5 general education prerequisites that must be “in-progress” during or completed by the end of the 1st Fall Semester: Human Anatomy, Statistics, Economics, Sociology, & Psychology
- **You MUST apply to the Professional Sequence while you are taking courses in your 1st Year Fall Semester**
