KNOW YOUR OPTIONS, RIGHTS AND REMEDIES

Chico State encourages victims of Sexual Misconduct to talk to someone about what happened, so you can get the support you need, and so the University can respond appropriately.

If you have experienced Sexual Misconduct we encourage you to speak with the campus Title IX Coordinator to ensure your

physical safety, emotional support and medical care.

Chico State's primary concern is the safety of its campus community members. Victims should not be deterred from reporting incidents of Sexual Misconduct out of a concern that they might be disciplined for related violations of drug,

alcohol, or other University policies.

Chico State will not require you to participate in any investigation or disciplinary proceeding if you do not wish to participate. However, the University may be required to conduct an investigation.
