

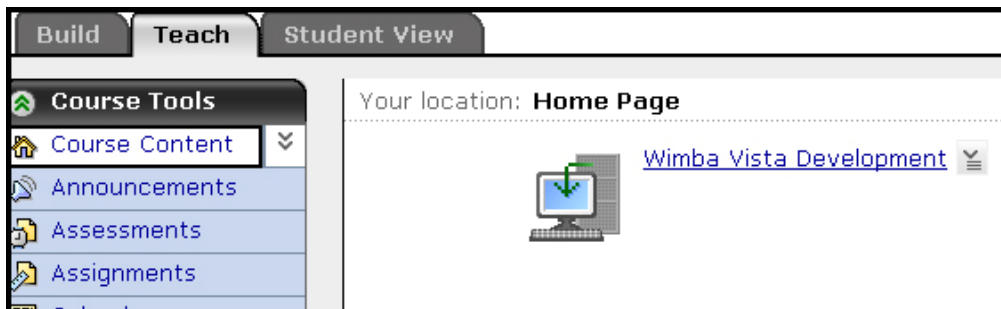
## Wimba Tutorial – How to Enable Participants to Use the eBoard

### Introduction

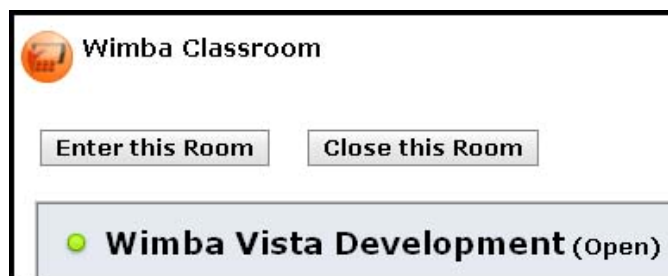
When you are in Live Classroom as a presenter you can use the eBoard. This tutorial will show you, the presenter, how to enable some (or all) participants to use the eBoard tools as well.

### Getting Started

1. Sign into Vista and go to the **Teach** tab.



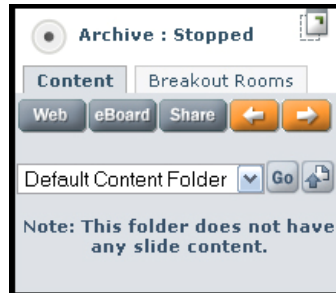
2. Click on the link to the Wimba course and select **Enter this Room**.



## Enabling eBoard Use

The **Enable** button on the eBoard toolbar allows one to enable as many or as few participants to use the eBoard tools. The participants will then be enabled to use the eBoard toolbar.

1. Under the content tab on the presenter's console click on **eBoard**.



2. On the eBoard toolbar click **Enable**.



3. Select a participant (or multiple participants using the **Ctrl** or **Apple Key**) from the **Disabled** column and click the **Update** button. Their names will be moved over to the **Enabled** column, and they will automatically see the eBoard tools appear in the Content Frame. To quickly enable all participants, click the **Enable All** button instead of selecting participants individually.
4. To disable participant access at any time, perform the reverse procedure by selecting their names from the **Enabled** column and clicking the **Update** button.
