

## Wimba Tutorial – How to Show a Web Page

### Introduction

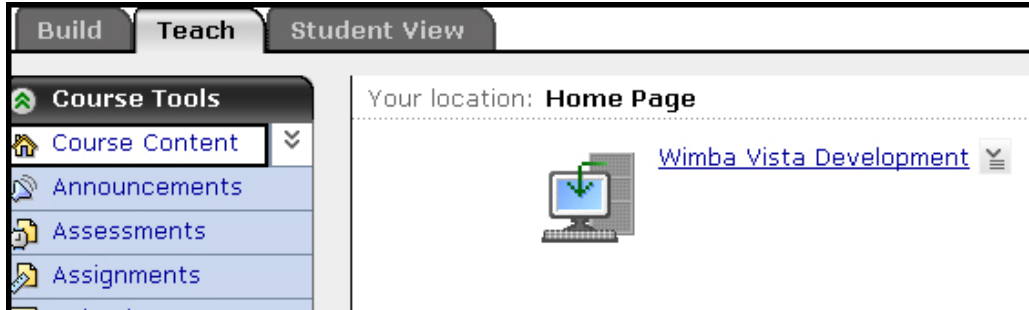
Although web pages can be added to your slide list in advance, you may also show them on-the-fly during a class session. This tutorial will explain how to do this, and give tips for best practices when showing web pages.

## Getting Started

1. Sign into Vista and go to the **Teach** tab.



2. Click on the link to the Wimba course and select **Enter this Room**.



## Showing a Web Page

1. While in the Wimba Classroom, look on the right hand side of the window and make sure that you are on the **Content Tab**. Click on **Web**. This will open the **Show a Web Page** window.



2. Type in the **URL** address of the web page you would like to show.



3. Choose where you would like the page to open. By default it will open in a new window.



**⚠ Notice:** Verbally instruct participants to expect a new window to appear. Verbal instructions should be given for the participants to navigate the web page. Since you cannot close the window for participants once you have displayed the web page, you should also verbally instruct participants to close or minimize this window when applicable

4. When you are finished click **Show Web Page**.



**⚠ Warning:** Some web pages can have information that will conflict with the Live Classroom interface if it is shown in the **content frame**; you should only use this option if it is absolutely necessary. When using this option, you should first display the web page in the **content frame (just for yourself)**. This way you will see how the web page will appear and can ensure that it displays properly, and then you can display it in the normal **content frame**.
