Aymer J. Hamilton	Indoor hallway, next to double doors on the northeast side.	Single stall, not accessible. Very small.
Center for Continuing Education	Inside next to stairs, enter southeast door.	Single stall, accessible.
Colusa Hall		Unisex restroom
Kendall Hall	At the west end of the hallway.	Single stall, accessible.
Meriam Library	Not in main library; located across the breezeway in hallway by Cross Cultural Leadership Center.	Two single stall, accessible.
Student Housing Office	Ask at the counter for an accessible or family restroom.	Single stall, accessible.
Student Health Center	First floor, ask for family restroom at Acute Care Desk. Second floor, ask Nurse's Station.	Single stall, accessible. These restrooms are generally reserved for faculty and staff only, but may be requested by students.
Trinity Hall	First floor, in elevator lobby next to art gallery.	Single stall, accessible. Contains a urinal.
WREC Center	First floor across from the elevator.	Family Bathroom
