California State University, Chico is seeking a director for the Institute for Sustainable Development, appointment effective spring 2010. The position is a half-time annual appointment with the expectation of a three-year commitment. The appointment is renewable.

Qualifications:

- Tenured faculty member at CSU, Chico at the rank of associate professor or above
- Demonstrated knowledge and experience with sustainability in teaching and research
- Demonstrated achievement in seeking and being awarded external grants and/or foundation funding
- Demonstrated experience with leadership and resource management
- Interest in and commitment to working within and beyond the University on matters of sustainability

Responsibilities:

- Serve as chief administrative officer of the Institute for Sustainable Development (ISD) reporting to the Provost through the Senior Vice Provost for Academic Affairs.
 - Supervise the work of Institute staff.
 - Manage the ISD budget.
 - Co-chair the campus-wide Sustainability Committee.
- Lead the ISD in planning and accountability.
 - Define the mission and strategic plan for the Institute, in alignment with the University's strategic priorities and the Academic Plan.
 - Lead implementation of the strategic plan for the ISD.
 - Annually report on progress in achieving the ISD strategic plan.
- Support the mission of the ISD through leading the development of external funding for ISD projects and programs.
- Represent the ISD and University internally and externally on opportunities for collaboration and education.
- Consult with faculty and academic leadership on curriculum and programs that address goals of the University Strategic Plan and the Academic Plan.
- Provide staffing support for the University's obligations with regard to planning and reporting on the Presidents' Climate Commitment.
- Work collaboratively with all divisions of the University on matters of sustainability.
- Other responsibilities as assigned.
