

# 2007–2008 Academic Calendar

## Fall Semester 2007

**October 1–November 30, 2006** **Priority Undergraduate Application Filing Period for fall 2007 admission.** Applicants to “impacted” majors must apply during this period. **Welcome to Admissions—Chico Preview Day on October 28.**

December 15, 2006 Last day to apply for a bachelor’s degree expected in December 2007.

**January 1–March 2, 2007** **Priority Filing Period for 2007/2008 financial aid applications.**

**February 1** **Last day to apply for 2007/2008 scholarships.**

March 1 Graduate and Credential Programs application deadline for fall 2007 admission.

April 6 Last day to file an appeal for academic reinstatement for fall 2007.

**April 16–August 1** **Registration (Priority),** check the *Class Schedule* on the CSU, Chico Web for registration begin/end dates.

June 5–July 27 Orientation programs and academic advising for new students.

**August 1** **Electronic Funds Transfer.** Last day to submit authorization to Student Financial Services to have EFT effective for August 23 disbursement

**August 1** **Registration (Priority) Deadline for fall 2007.**

**August 2** **Registration Fee Payment Deadline.** Students who fail to pay fees or do not have sufficient financial aid to pay fees will be assessed a late fee, will not be able to add classes during Registration Add/Drop Period, and may have classes dropped for non-payments.

**August 6–September 7** **Registration Add/Drop Period.** You must have paid fees or have sufficient anticipated aid to pay fees to add classes.

August 22–24 Orientation Activity for new students—*Getting Connected.*

August 22 Academic year begins; all faculty on duty.

**August 23** **Financial Aid Refunds.** First financial aid refunds disbursed by Electronic Funds Transfer or mail to students who have met all processing requirements and who have a credit balance after total charges are paid.

August 26 Last day to drop all classes to receive a full refund (less an administrative fee).

**August 27** **Fall Classes Begin.**

August 27 Term withdrawals on or after this date (but by October 29) will be eligible for a pro-rata refund of registration fees and non-resident tuition.

**September 3** **Labor Day—campus closed.**

**September 7** **Last day to add or drop classes without special permission of instructor.** Students need a serious and compelling reason to add and drop classes after this date, and must use the COP process. Last day to drop classes (if remaining enrolled) to receive financial credit.

**September 21** **Census Date—**no adding, dropping of classes, or changing of grade option beyond this date without a serious and compelling reason approved by the instructor, department chair, and college dean.

September 21 Last day for Open University students to pay fees without late charge. Deadline for master’s students who are not regularly enrolled to register for adjunct enrollment. Last day to apply for a master’s degree expected in December 2007.

October 2 A late fee for each submission of a Change of Program (COP) form begins.

October 12 Last day to submit undergraduate Special Major application to be effective fall 2007.

October 19 Last day to apply without a late charge for a California teaching credential expected in December 2007.

October 29 Withdrawals after this date will not receive any financial credit for refund.

**November 12** **Veterans Day Observed—no classes held.**

**November 19–23** **Thanksgiving Vacation—no classes held.**

December 3 Last day for master’s degree candidates to take oral/comprehensive examination, submit thesis/terminal project, and submit final progress sheet to Graduate Studies.

December 3–December 21 Dropping classes permitted only because of serious illness or accident and with the approval of the college dean.

**December 17–21** **Final Exam Week—**see Final Examination Schedule in the *Class Schedule* on the CSU, Chico Web.

December 17–January 7, 2008 Fall semester grades due in Student Records and Registration Office. Deadline is noon, January 7.

December 24–January 4, 2008 Winter Vacation—campus closed.

December 31 Fall 2007 semester ends. Official fall semester graduation date.

## January Intersession 2008

**October 15–December 7, 2007** **January Intersession Real-Time Registration period for state-supported courses.** Fees for Intersession state-supported courses will be collected using spring registration procedures.

**November 1, 2007–January 7, 2008** **January Intersession registration period for courses offered through the Center for Regional and Continuing Education.**

**January 7** **Intersession Classes Begin.**

**January 8** **Last day to add or drop Intersession classes online.**

January 9–25 Use Change of Program (COP) process to add or drop classes. Instructor’s permission required.

**January 21** **Martin Luther King, Jr.’s Birthday—campus closed.**

January 22–25 Use the COP process to add, drop, or change grading option. You need a serious and compelling reason and approval signatures by the instructor, department chair, and college dean are required.

**January 25** **Last day of Intersession classes.**

May 19–May 30 Intersession grades due in Student Records and Registration Office. Deadline is noon, May 30.
