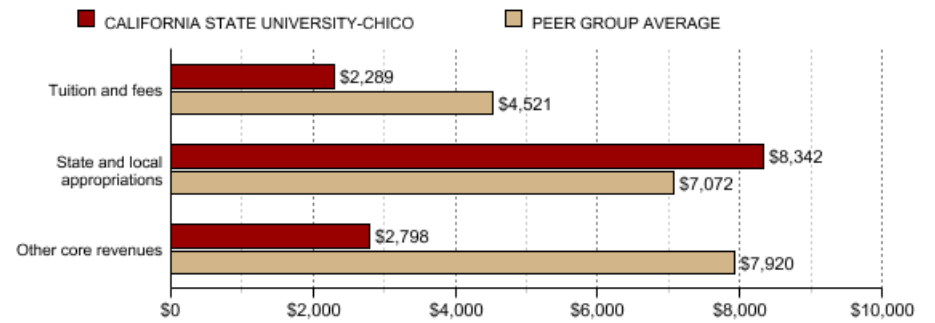

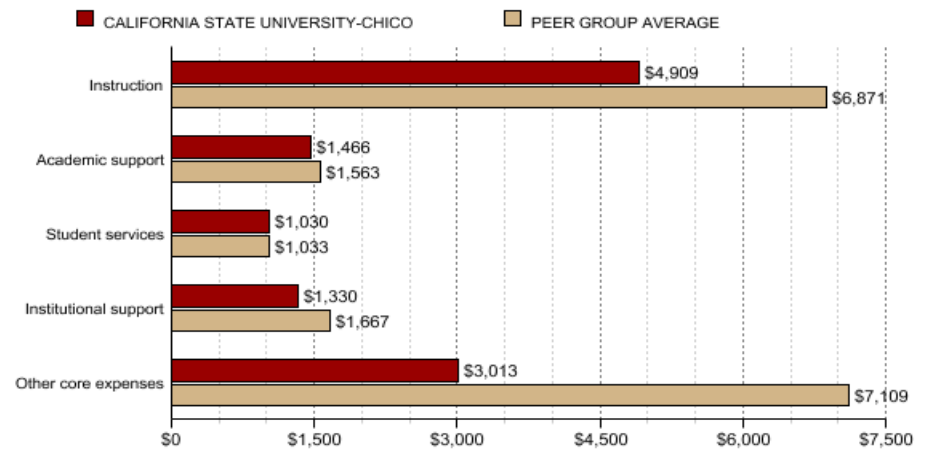

Core expenses per FTE student, by function: Fiscal year 2003



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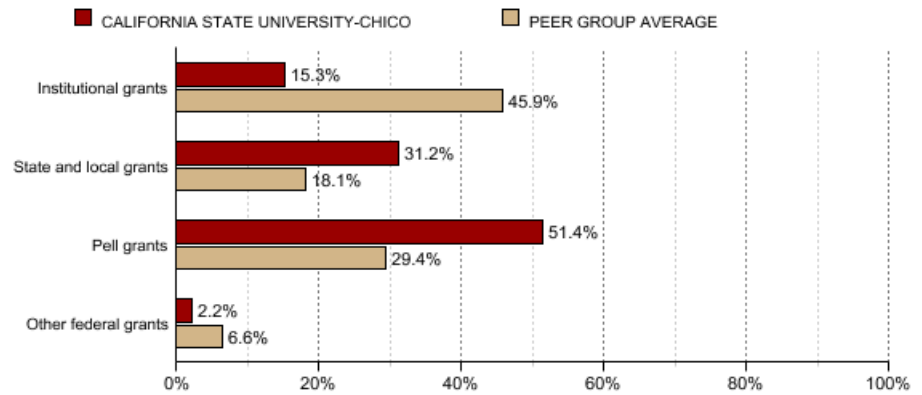

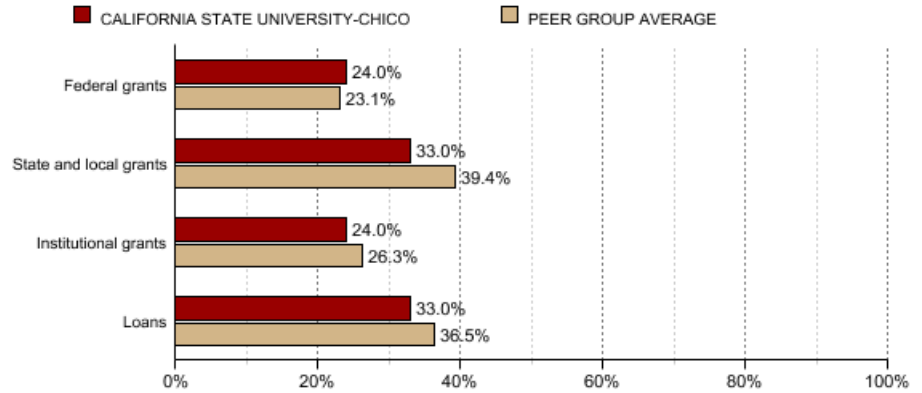

Percent of first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students receiving financial aid, by type of aid: Academic year 2002-03



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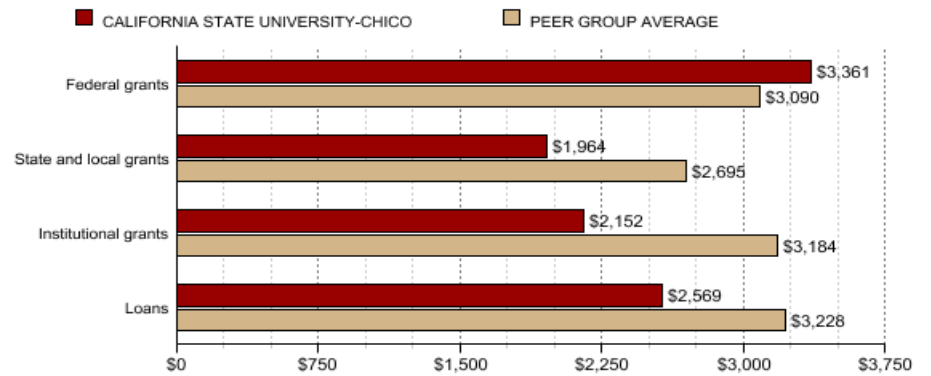

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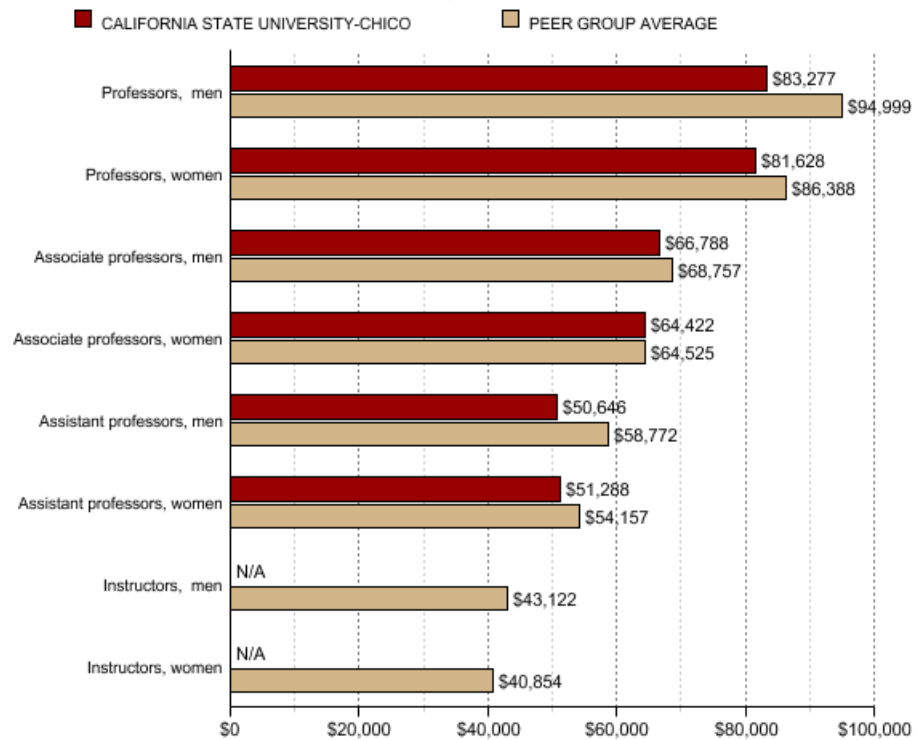

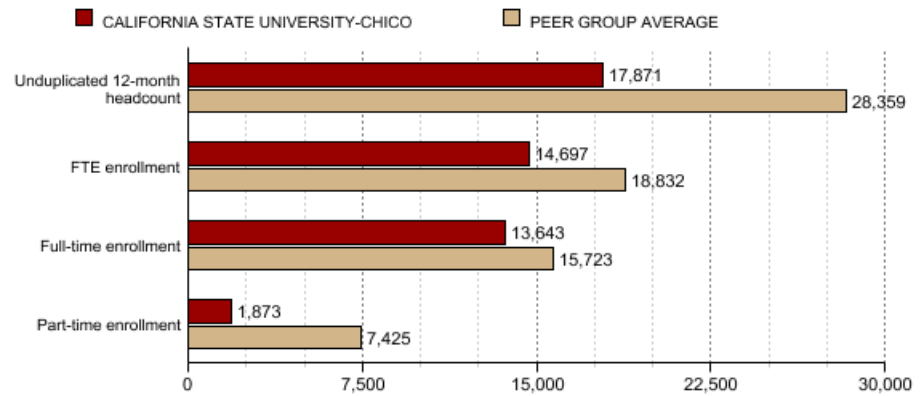
Average full-time instructional faculty salaries for equated 9-month contracts, by selected academic ranks and gender: Academic year 2003-04

Figure nine is concerned with instructional staff and their utilization. It contains several statistics including: (1) the percent of all employees whose primary responsibility is instruction or is instruction/research/ public service which indicates the percent of the institution's staff resources that are put into instruction; (2) the percent of instructional staff that have faculty status; (3) the percent of instructional staff that are full-time which indicates how the institution approaches staffing one of its core missions and how instructional staff are utilized; and (4) the percent of full-time instructional faculty that have tenure which indicates the stability of the instructional staff and may indicate how difficult it would be for an institution to downsize its instructional faculty or change the composition of its instructional staff.
