- ◆ In order to protect fish and wildlife, cut or tear the plastic six-pack rings before throwing them away, this can help save wildlife from choking on the plastic rings.
- ◆ When you go shopping bring your own reusable bags to help you carry home your purchases. This saves the trees and cuts down on the amount being put in the dumps. Also, some stores will give you discounts if you bring your own bags.
- ◆ Do not let the faucet run when you are brushing your teeth, shaving, washing the dishes or washing the car. This can save your water bill.
- ◆ Regularly recycle paper, plastic, glass and aluminum. There are several places on campus where you can do this, including the Residence Halls and the BMU.
