Additional Nursing Units, up to 16, may be used as part of the 70 transferable units. Mendocino AD RN program has 51 transferable nursing units; 36 are used. 54 other CSU transferable units are needed. Mendocino LVN to RN students have 26 or more transferable nursing units. They will likely need 64 other CSU transferable units to qualify for the Chico State RN to BSN Program, unless they</p>
