Policy for Clinical Requirements

All clinical requirements must be submitted to SentryMD by **May 11, 2026**. Students who do not submit their clinical requirements by the semester deadline will have a 10% reduction in the final grade for each of their clinical courses in Fall 2026 semester for unprofessionalism. Safe Medication Administration and Dosage Calculation Assessment

All 3rd semester students must verify competency in the safe administration of medications and medication dosage calculations before being eligible to give meds during hospital clinicals in NURS 314 and NURS 344. The proctored Safe Medication Administration and Dosage Calculation Assessment will be administered on **Friday, August 28, 2026**, from 1400-1600 following the NURS 314 Orientation. An optional Zoom tutorial will be offered prior to this on **Tuesday, August 25, 2026**, from 1500-1600. The proctored assessment is a 1-hour, in-person assessment completed online. Scratch paper will be provided. Students are permitted 100 minutes to complete the assessment and must do so with 90% accuracy to be eligible to give meds during clinicals. As a non-point-based general competency evaluation, the assessment cannot be taken at ARC. A re-take date/time for anyone who does not complete the assessment with 90% accuracy is TBA.

Semester 3 Maternal-Child Course Information

NURS 313 – Maternal/Child Lecture

NURS 313 is the maternal/child lecture course which is taught in two separate 2-hour lectures (OB and Peds) for the entire semester. Some lectures may be recorded and viewed asynchronously.

NURS 314 –Maternal/Child Practicum

NURS 314 is the 135-hour clinical component conducted taught at Enloe Health in Chico and Mercy Medical Center in Redding. All sections rotate through acute (hospital) OB and Pediatrics and have additional required activities, including skills lab, assignments, and simulation training.

FIRST WEEKS OF THE SEMESTER

The first 3 weeks of the semester have some additional days required prior to beginning hospital clinicals. Orientations are **MANDATORY** and no make-up session is available.

A few days prior to the beginning of school, your Canvas course page will be available that contains your syllabus and course supplement. Entrance to orientation requires an uploaded copy of the ATI CERTIFICATE showing completion of the HIPAA module (you complete these three times during the nursing program).

NURS314 Simulations

There are three Maternal/Child simulations conducted at the Northern California Rural Simulation Center, 1390 E Lassen Avenue, Chico, CA 95973. Please wear your CSUC scrubs and bring your stethoscope. Each session includes a one-hour prep and 3 hours in the Simulation Center.

NURS 314-01 & 02 Enloe Medical Center

NURS 314-01 consists of 10 clinical days at Enloe on Tuesdays from 0630-1700.

NURS 314-02 consists of 10 clinical days at Enloe on Friday and Saturdays from 0630-1700.

Please Note: Up to 10 hours of OAKs (online reading and tests) are due on the first day of the semester. You will receive an email from Enloe prior to the start of the semester to access these modules with these words in the Subject heading: epm-alerts@elsevier.com. Please follow the link to complete your modules. You must have these completed or you will be removed from your clinical section.

A mandatory facility orientation will be on **Tuesday, August 25, 2026, 1000-1200** at the Enloe Conference Center.

NURS 314-03 & 04 Mercu Medical Center, Redding

NURS 314-03 & 04 consists of 10 clinical days on Friday and Saturdays from 0630-1700.

Please Note: Up to 10 hours of modules and Cerner training (online reading and tests) are due prior to the start of clinical. You will receive an email from Dignity Health Mercy Medical Center prior to the start of the semester to access these modules.

Semester 3 Medical-Surgical Nursing Information

NURS 343 Medical-Surgical Nursing II (Lecture)

This course is a 3-unit continuation of NURS 302 and covers the pathophysiology, pharmacology, and nursing care of adults with medical disorders not covered in NURS 302. The course meets from 0800-1100 every Wednesday in Holt Hall 363, and the first meeting will be Wednesday, August 27, 2025. The syllabus, course calendar, and other information will be published in Canvas before the semester begins. Textbooks will be the same as those for NURS 302.

NURS 344 Medical-Surgical Nursing II Clinical

This 90-hour clinical practicum meets on Mondays at various clinical host facilities. The course includes two simulation experiences (3 hours each) at the Northern California Rural SimCenter, Chico, CA, and two Skills Labs (3 hours each – locations TBA), also scheduled on Mondays.

NURS 344-01 – Enloe Medical Center, Chico, CA – Various units. 8 hours each Monday (except for Simulation/Skills days) for a total of 80 hours (10 clinical days). Faculty will provide students with actual dates of attendance. A mandatory facility orientation will be on **Tuesday, August 25, 2026, 1000-1200** at the Enloe Conference Center. In-hospital clinical experience begins on **Monday, August 31, 2026, 0630-1500**. Also, please see note below. Register for this section if you completed NURS 304 at Enloe in Fall 2025.

NURS 344-02 – Enloe Medical Center, Chico, CA – Various units. 8 hours each Monday (except for Simulation/Skills days) for a total of 80 hours (10 clinical days). Faculty will provide students with actual dates of attendance. A mandatory facility orientation will be on **Tuesday, August 25, 2026, 1000-1200** at the Enloe Conference Center. In-hospital clinical experience begins on **Monday, August 31, 2026, 0630-1500**. Also, please see note below. Register for this section if you completed NURS 304 at Enloe in Fall 2025.

Please Note: Up to 10 hours of online reading and tests (OAK Modules) are due on the first day of the semester. You will receive an email from Enloe approximately 2-3 weeks before the start of the semester with the subject heading: epm-alerts@elsevier.com. Please follow the link in the email to access and complete the modules. Enloe insists that these be completed or the CSUC School of Nursing will remove you from your clinical section.

NURS 344-03 – Oroville Hospital, Oroville, CA – Various units. 12 and/or 8 hours each Monday for a total of 80 hours (variable number of clinical days). Faculty will provide students with exact dates of attendance. A mandatory facility orientation will be held at

Oroville Hospital, date TBA, most likely on the first Monday of the semester after Simulation. Register for this section if you completed NURS 304 at Oroville Hospital in Fall 2025.

NURS 344-04 – Adventist Health + Rideout, Marysville, CA – Variable units. 12 and/or 8 hours each Monday for a total of 80 hours (variable number of clinical days). Orientation will be at the Adventist Health + Rideout Education Center in Yuba City, CA, date TBA. This will be the first 12- hour day, and you will start clinical hours in the hospital following orientation. Register for this section if you completed NURS 304 at Adventist Health + Rideout in Fall 2025.
