  - 64% of titles (68% of courses) by buy back 12/11/13
- Fall 2013
  - 13% of titles (11% of courses) by due date 4/1/13
  - 57% of titles (63% of courses) by buy back 5/14/13

# UC Berkeley Alternate Media Settlement

## ○ **Synopsis**

- Disability Rights Advocates (DRA) represented 3 students with print disabilities regarding barriers to alternate media.
- The parties used a 'structured negotiation process' (vs. lawsuit) that took more than a year to complete.
- Focused primarily on timely access to materials as well as library accessibility (print books/journals and catalog software)

## ○ **Outcomes**

- Implement shorter alternate media delivery timelines
  - Textbooks: 10 business days
  - Course readers: 17 business days
  - Portions of critical materials: shorter (not specified in fact sheet)
  - Delivery of timely requests 3 days prior to start of class

# UC Berkeley Alternate Media Settlement (cont)

## ○ **Outcomes (cont)**

- Deliver 'recommended' materials in accessible formats
- Provide 'interim services' (e.g. personal reader, deadline extension)
- **Improve library accessibility capacity/procedures**
  - Remediate online library catalog software for screen reader access
  - New library print conversion system to convert within 5 business days
  - Implement scanning machines to allow self-service by students
  - Provide assistance with scanning for those with physical disabilities

## ○ **Discussion**

- Likely precedent-setting for future OCR investigations/lawsuits
- The timelines are challenging when applied to all requests
- Alt media capacity requires investments to meet growing demands
- Print disability issues extend beyond blindness
