NOTE: University regulations require that you must complete both semesters of Honors coursework in order to participate in commencement with honors recognition. If you participate in the Spring commencement ceremony before completing CHLD 495H in the Fall, you will be recognized for your Honors work during the next Spring commencement.

Faculty member who has agreed to be your sponsor and mentor in your honors coursework:

To be eligible you must have met the following criteria:

- Successful complete of 9 units of upper division coursework or 21 units in your major.
- Successful completion of CHLD 353
- A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.5 or placement within the top 5% of all University majors.
- GPA of at least 3.5 in Child Development coursework or placement within the top 5% of Child Development majors.
- Senior status with two semesters of undergraduate coursework remaining
- Acquisition of a faculty sponsor and mentor
- Completion and submission of the Honors in Child Development Program application
- An essay consisting of several word processed, double-spaced pages consisting of:
 - 1) An explanation of why you wish to participate in the Honors Program
 - 2) A commentary on your academic strengths and weaknesses
 - 3) A reflection of your learning experience in CHLD 353
 - 4) A discussion and explanation of at least two areas of research identified on the Faculty Research Interests list that you would be interested in pursuing, and why
 - 5) A review of an area of interest that you find particularly fascinating that is not on the faculty research list
 - 6) A description of your specific career goals
