 - Making opportunities for faculty-place connections through taking pictures and sharing information about the community.
- **Nate Millard – Project with Paradise Parks**
 - Paradise parks listening sessions facilitation opportunity.
 - Great opportunity for students to learn skill in how to facilitate and observe public gatherings.
 - Identify students who may be interested in learning more about community organizing and facilitation of this kind of work.
- **Summer Civic Engagement faculty workshop**
 - Finalizing plans for recruitment for a two-day workshop for faculty to be held tentatively May 27 and 28, with a 2-hour meeting in the fall to present any work products.
