Foundation Directory Online

As a member institution, the Chico State Meriam Library provides access to the Foundation Center's Foundation Directory Online, a grant seeking research database. **Covid-19 Access:** The Meriam Library has been given remote access to the [Foundation Directory Online Essential](#). FDO Essential is a subset of the Library's FDO Professional database. FDO Essential contains 103,000 records only from private and independent foundations, while FDO Professional contains 189,000 records from private and individual foundations, corporate foundations, U.S. federal funders, public charities, and international foundations. Also during this period, Meriam Library librarians will be able to access FDO Professional remotely.
