ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Work collaboratively with the Learning Community Clinician to develop and implement a linguistically diverse learning community for the CSUC School of Social Work's Bilingual Bridges Behavioral (BBB) Health program.
- Meet weekly, individually or in groups, with BBB students to provide language support and answer questions regarding academic and work-life balance.
- Meet with the BBB team and/or Learning Community Clinician at least twice a month.
- Attend all BBB required trainings as directed by Behavioral Health Program team.
- Assist the BBB team in planning, organizing, and facilitating social and team-building activities.
- Communicate with Behavioral Health Program team about student progress and concerns.
- Five hours per week per semester (18 weeks/semester; 36 weeks total)
